PROPER CABINET CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Thank you for your business! Please follow the recommended cleaning and care guidelines listed below in order to keep your cabinets looking their best.

Spills: Clean spills quickly with a damp cloth and mild soap. Wipe dry with a clean, soft cloth.

Note: **DO NOT** use a dish cloth to wipe your cabinets exterior since it may contain remnants of grease and/or food particles.

General Cleaning: Wood cabinetry finishes may be cleaned and protected by using an emulsion- type cleaner such as Murphy's Oil Soap (these are formulated without wax, petroleum solvents or silicones). The extended use of wax polishes can result in a wax film buildup which acts as a layer of protection for the cabinet, while the use of silicone polishes can harm the cabinets finish.

Polishing: We recommend that you clean and polish your stain grade cabinets at least once a year. Finish by adding a light coat of quality furniture polish. Guardsman furniture polish produces good results.

Painted Finishes: Use mild soap with water.

Thermafoil or Melamine Surfaces: Occasionally clean the exterior and interior surfaces of the door using a soft damp cloth. For stubborn stains or spot cleaning a Magic Eraser works well on melamine finishes.

DON'T'S: Never use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads or powdered cleansers. Detergents, soap pads, or steel wool can damage your cabinetry. DO NOT use products with bleach or ammonia. DO NOT leave damp cloths on cabinets for long periods of time. DO NOT use appliances that create heat or steam under or around the cabinetry- the steam and heat will damage the cabinet finish; pull small appliances away from cabinets before using.
